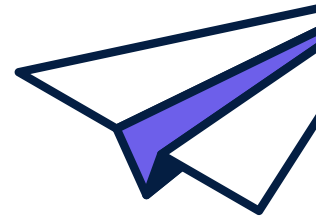

The software also comes with a helpful community forum that connects program managers so they can collaborate and share ideas.

Where SmarterSelect shines is in its ability to simplify the application creation and review process. With templates and plug and play forms your organization could have a brand new program up and running in less than a day. The scoring rubrics and disqualification settings also make it much faster and easier to find the exact candidates that are deserving of your awards. SmarterSelect also offers a free trial that allows you to test out many of its features to ensure it's what your organization is looking for from available scholarship management systems.

Perhaps one of its few flaws is that it doesn't offer customer support by phone. However, it does make up for this by providing responsive stellar in-app chat support, email and live web-based training that can solve nearly any issue that may come up. The learning curve is minimal, and most users find they can quickly understand its features and begin using it right away.

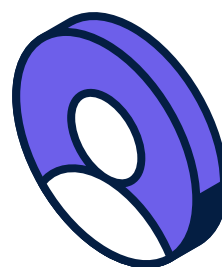
What are its strengths and limitations?

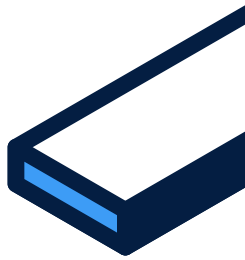


What are its strengths and limitations?

Though some scholarship reviews websites have indicated the pricing begins at \$119 per month, you'll actually have to contact the company to get hard numbers.

Who is it most suitable for?

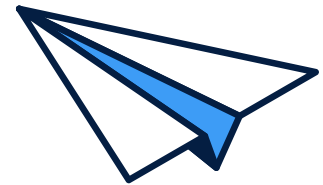

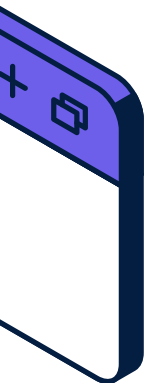
What are its strengths and limitations?

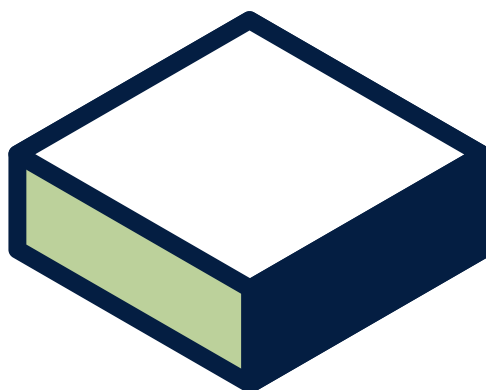
5. WizeHive

WizeHive scholarship management software is a comprehensive platform that makes it easy for organizations to manage the scholarship application process. WizeHive grants all the necessary tools for scholarship administrators, including an applicant tracking system, automated review of applications, award notification management and funds management.

Who is it most suitable for?

This software is perfect for Private foundations and corporations, educational institutions, and businesses and groups that want to set up a scholarship program that seeks applicants and reviews them to give away scholarship funds.





What are its strengths and limitations?

WizeHive was built to save program managers and teams time. Its biggest strength is that when using WizeHive the application process is streamlined from application creation to recipient selection. While their pricing is not publicly available, Capterra indicated the pricing begins at \$3995 per year. Like other options for scholarship management software in this list, this number could be a limitation for small and nonprofit organizations. Unfortunately, there's no indication as to how many users that fee limits you too or if you can run multiple programs at that cost either.

Why should you look for an alternative to WizeHive?

Perhaps one of the biggest reasons you should look for an alternative to WizeHive is you prefer working with companies who are transparent in their pricing structures. You shouldn't have to play a guessing game or waste your valuable time speaking to a pushy sales rep to get the information you need. 6. AwardSpring



AwardSpring scholarship management software is a comprehensive software solution that helps you manage your scholarship program and process submissions from applicants. It simplifies the tasks of accepting and awarding scholarships with ease by tracking the necessary information for each scholarship and providing an online application process that doesn't require any additional materials.



Who is it most suitable for?

AwardSpring is best suited to scholarship programs that only have one scholarship that they are giving away funds for. If you have multiple programs running at the same time, you'll be faced with additional fees.





What are its strengths and limitations?

In terms of strengths, AwardSpring, like many of the scholarship management software options in this guide, is easy to use. Just like several of the options mentioned, it helps you manage your scholarship program, makes it easy to create an online application, and streamlines the review process as well. Where it is lacking however, is in the ability to run and give away multiple scholarships concurrently. The fees begin at \$99 per month, but that is only for the first scholarship. On AwardSpring's "NOW" plan, you are limited to five total scholarships, and you'll pay \$29 per month for each additional scholarship on top of your \$99 fee for the first one. While their PRO plan solves this problem offering 25 scholarships, the cost balloons to a base price of \$4500 per year with no indication as to how many users you will be limited to.

7. Evalato



At its core, Evalato is a powerful scholarship management software that is designed to help non-profit and for-profit organizations, and everyone in between, to manage their scholarship programs. Why should you look for an alternative to Evalato?

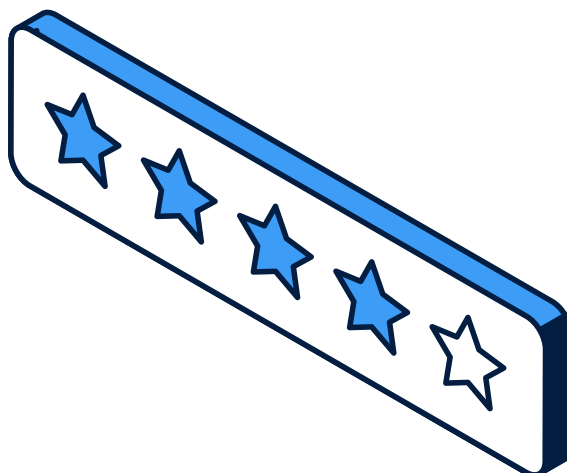

This scholarship management software is ideal for organizations that need a way to collect and manage online submissions, and are okay with the learning curve that may be required to fully utilize all of its functionality.



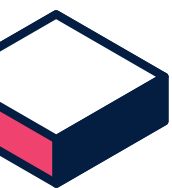


What are its strengths and limitations?

However, as scholarship reviews websites have indicated, the platform is not always the easiest to use, and it's quite limited in terms of customization without customer support. As one user explained, nearly every customization they attempted to complete required contacting support. Another shared that the backend dashboard for administrators could be perceived as quite intimidating. Then again, once you get past the learning curve and setup, it should be smooth sailing.

Why should you look for an alternative to Reviewr?

If you're shopping for scholarship management software, the biggest reason you should look for an alternative to Reviewr is they don't offer public pricing. 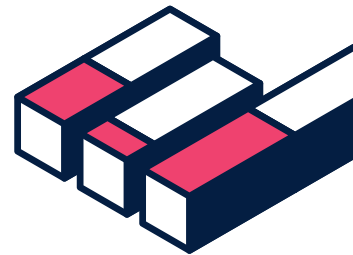
9. Submittable
